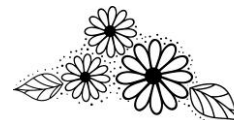

On 11th February I shall be holding a coffee morning for the Stand By me 2023 Shoe appeal and your support in any way would be much appreciated.

Stand By me support 4000 children who need new shoes twice a year.

From Colombia to Kenya. Myanmar, Ethiopia, Nepal and Romania.

I have just received a letter from them, and in it their Director in Romania explains why this gift of shoes is so important to their children:

“In Romania, kids wear through their shoes very fast, especially during the cold seasons. In winter due to cold snow or rain, kids need more than one pair of shoes to make sure their feet stay dry and warm every day. Winter is also the hardest time for families, with big heating bills and the stop of construction work which means less work for many parents.

Thank you for the gift of shoes”

Stand By me says that thanks to those who support them, their children will be “filled with joy walking tall and knowing they belong.

Thank you for enabling us to meet the needs of our children and enabling us to share God’s love with them.”
