Toilet Twinning is a water and sanitation initiative. With every £60 raised, the charity can start an education project to raise awareness about sanitation and hygiene – and build a village latrine.

### MUSIC IN NEW MALDEN – THIS AFTERNOON at 3pm

**J.S. Bach - Sonata No 2 in D major for Viola da gamba and Cembalo, BWV 1028**  
**Sergei Prokofiev - Sonata for Cello and Piano in C major, Op. 119**

Please join us to welcome local musicians Mary Mundy, formerly sub-principal cellist with the Orchestra of the Royal Opera House, and Henry Roche, a pianist who has worked extensively with the Royal Ballet.

They will perform a contrasting programme, beginning with a Sonata by J.S. Bach, followed by Prokofiev's Sonata for Cello and Piano. The second piece was described by a fellow composer at the time as "a miraculous piece of music", so not one to be missed!

As always, there will be the opportunity afterwards to talk to the performers over tea and cake. There will be a retiring collection in aid of Kingston Churches Action on Homelessness, and a separate collection for the MiNM Expenses Fund.
