The cross now glows, the wood in the church shines and the building smells of polish. Again many thanks and keep an eye out for the next big clean.

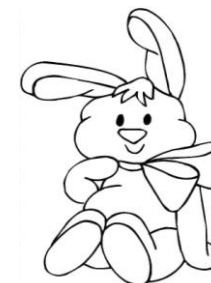
The Church collection for 16th February was £370.96 plus an average for weekly direct giving of £606.
