GOD IN LOVE UNITES US Circuit Conversation 10am-12noon Saturday 18th January

God in Love Unites Us is the title of a new Methodist report on marriage and relationships. The report proposes some important changes in our understanding of marriage – including a recommendation that it should be possible for same sex couples to marry in a Methodist Church. But the report is about far more than this. It reflects deeply and prayerfully on our understanding of marriage and relationships. It explores what it means for couples to "cohabit" without being formally married, it seeks to understand the needs of those who don't easily fit into our usual ways of thinking about "female" and "male". It looks at the qualities of good Christian relationships of all kinds.

The Conference has formally "received" the report and asked for a wide consultation before making a final decision on the key issues in summer 2020.
