On Sunday, March 4th I will be once again walking the Marsden March to help raise funds for the Royal Marsden Hospitals. I will be walking 14 miles from the Fulham hospital to the Sutton hospital. I have done this several times before but this year will be the toughest. It will be nearly a year since I had major surgery for melanoma (skin cancer) and then had the lymph nodes removed from my groin. This has left me with nerve damage and problems with the way the lymph fluid drains from my leg. Though I'm not treated at the Marsden, the pioneering work that they do there for new treatments has meant that I have a future to look forward to and an ever improving prognosis.
