Music in New Malden invites you to join us for the penultimate concert of this series, featuring music for clarinet and strings by Brahms and his contemporary Robert Fuchs. Jane Booth and Jacqueline Ross, both professors at the Guildhall School of Music Drama, will be joined by Guildhall students and fellows.

Robert Fuchs, a 19th-century Austrian composer whose students include Mahler and Sibelius, was greatly admired by Brahms. This concert will feature his quintet for clarinet and strings, and three duos for violin and viola. This will be followed by one of the most-loved pieces in the clarinet repertoire, which Brahms wrote for the clarinettist Richard Mühlfeld in 1891.

As always, there will be the opportunity afterwards to talk to the performers over tea and cake. We hope you will be able to join us!
