Music in New Malden are busy putting the finishing touches to the 2023-24 programme of concerts and it promises to be a bumper one, with several new instruments for MiNM, including classical guitar and the organ, together with welcome returns by New Malden Voices and The Harmonie Choir. Full details will follow shortly.



The Committee has been some work on the future development of MiNM now audiences are returning more-or-less to pre-Covid levels.

Since Jane and John founded the series in 2008, it has come a long way, providing more realistic professional fees, and introducing students and community groups to bring the widest range of top quality music to a venue where many are able to walk to concerts. They are justifiably proud of the educational outreach achieved

locally - supported on two occasions by grants from Kingston Council - giving several hundred pupils at Burlington Junior School the opportunity to hear inspiring professional musicians performing at the school. The concerts are reasonably well-known locally plus a mailing-list of over 400, but MiNM feel their efforts could be better focused and we could enter into a more fruitful dialogue with those of you who attend reasonably often. The proposal is to establish a list of subscribers who, for a modest £5 membership charge each year, will become voting members of MiNM and entitled to attend our General Meeting where accounts are presented (rather overdue following when it was difficult to meet), the past reviewed and the way forward explored. If this doesn't sound an entirely attractive prospect, a short concert will follow the meeting when two outstanding young brother musicians – Jamie and Rory Zweimueller – will entertain us; between them they play the flute, violin, cello and piano to a very high standard and the chance to hear them in concert should not be missed.

To obtain membership and a free ticket for the concert after the GM on Sunday 24th September 2023 at 3pm just go to the TicketSource site www.ticketsource.co.uk/musicinnm (QR nearby) and subscribe £5 for each.

A change will also be made to ticket prices. It has been found that the large proportion of tickets bought on the door is difficult; partly because of logistics (including change), but also because of the difficulty in providing the right quantity of tea for afterwards. Tickets bought in advance (either on line or from Wesley's) will be £8 as before, but tickets bought on the door will be £10 and the subscription



ticket will be discontinued as it was sold in small quantities and the term may be confusing with our new Annual Subscription.
