To mark the Marie Curie National Day of Reflection, Princess Alice Hospice is working with Kew Gardens to offer a special day to remember all those who have died during the pandemic (not necessarily of Covid-19). Anyone who has been bereaved during this time is offered free entry into Kew for up to four people and the opportunity to attend a short service of remembrance.
