You will probably have heard by now that King Charles III is coming to New Malden!!

His Majesty is coming to New Malden ahead of a Korean state visit to the UK to meet local Korean Community and Cultural groups. NMMC was asked to be the focal point for the visit to host the various meetings with Korean local groups as we have the ideal location in the heart of the High Street.

The visit will take place on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November at around 1.45pm for about an hour.

For obvious security reasons the Palace have tight control on the visit and only those authorised people who are directly involved in the visit will have access to the Church.

Also, Wesley's will not be open to the public at all on that day. However, people are encouraged to congregate outside in the High Street for when the King arrives and departs and we will serve tea and coffee in Wesley's when His Majesty has left.

### Music in New Malden Sunday 12th November 3.00pm

Matt White (classical guitar)

Matt White started playing the guitar at the age of 8 and went on to study at the Royal College Of Music with Charles Ramirez, Carlos Bonell and Gary Ryan, graduating in 2005. He has participated in masterclasses with John Williams, Ricardo Iznaola, Bill Kanengiser and Craig Ogden among others. Matt's recital programmes are varied and include music from the renaissance to the twenty first century. He has performed in London's Bolivar Hall and across Europe as a soloist (concerts in the UK, Norway, Switzerland and Italy).

He will also talk about the instrument and repertoire - rather like the earlier series of Music in New Malden, when players from Ensemble DeNOTE introduced their sometimes unfamiliar fortepianos, classical clarinets, baroque violins, natural horns, and so on!
