I have now been informed by the contractor who will undertake a repair that the manufacturer is fabricating the combustion chambers at the moment which they will then dispatch to the merchants. The boiler contractor is estimating the receipt of these is the first week in November when they will contact me with a view to arranging an appointment for overhauling the heat exchanger and installing the combustion chambers. We will need to hope that the warm temperatures that we have been experiencing recently will continue. *Mick Taviner*
